## **Report of NSS Activity**

Sub: Observance of Swachhta Pakhwara by the NSS Units of Sri Sankara Arts and Science College, Enathur, Kanchipuram, between 01/08/2017 and 15/08/2017.

Action Plan of activities and programmes conducted by the NSS Units of Sri Sankara Arts and Science College.

#### 1. Swachhta Pakhwara Programme First Day (01/08/2017)

Observance of Swachhta Pakhwara Programme was begun with Prayer Song. Welcome address was given by Mr. E. Praveen Kumar, Programme Officer, Unit I. Chief Guests were honoured by all Programme Officers. In this connection a one day seminar was conducted on the topic "Sanitation and Hygiene in Rural India – Issues and Schemes". It was presented by Dr. K.R. Venkatesan, Principal, Sri Sankara Arts and Science College, Kanchipuram, at 10.00 am in Kanchi Maha Periyava Prayer Hall. Hundred NSS Student Volunteers took part in the programme. After the presentation, few students gave their feed backs. The event came to an end with the Swachhta Shapath, read by Mr. E. Manigandan, Programme Officer, and the oath was taken by all NSS Volunteers and Officers. Towards the end of the programme, Mr. E. Manigandan, delivered the Vote of Thanks.

#### 2. College Campus Cleaning (02/08/2017 – 05/08/2017)

As per the schedule given by the University, all the NSS Units and 150 NSS Student Volunteers of our college devoted the next four days (from 2/8/2017 to 5/8/2017) for cleaning the campus of our college. During the four days all the 150 NSS Volunteers committed to the task of cleaning the campus between 9 am and 5 pm. On 2/8/2017 J Block and S Block Classrooms were cleaned and also a set of volunteers dramatized a skit on importance of cleanliness in each and every class. Next day, Volunteers cleaned the college Campus and Auditorium. Likely, on 3<sup>rd</sup> August, 2017, library and laboratories were cleaned. August 5<sup>th</sup>, 2017 was the last day of the College Campus Cleaning Programme. On that day, volunteers swiped the large Playground, lawn and roads of the college.

#### 3. Visiting the Adopted Villages

From 6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> August 2017, our NSS Units visited adopted villages and slums. They served at Enathur on 6/8/2017; Nallur on 7/8/2017; Gowri Amman Pet and Chettiyar Pet on 8/8/2017. These three days, NSS Volunteers made door to door campaign display of banners and placards, awareness procession, skit and drama to create awareness on clean environment, construction of toilet to make open defecation free villages, and spread the message on importance of cleanliness to each and every person in the villages.

#### 4. Cleaning the Adopted Villages (9/08/2017 & 10/08/2017)

Our NSS Volunteers took a step ahead in spreading the message of cleaning by their efforts made in the villages. In the two day they intensively cleaned the villages and slums, in order to make the villagers to understand the dignity of labour, develop a habit of keeping their surrounding clean and involve in the programme effectively.

In extend of Observance of Swachhta Pakhwara Programme, from Sri Sankara Arts & Science College, Mr.VijayaKumar, Assistant NSS Programme Officer along with 30 NSS Volunteers have participated in University of Madras Campus Cleaning work on 09.08.2017 by 9.00am to 5.00pm.

#### 5. Visiting Orphanages

Between 11<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> August 2017, our hundred NSS Volunteers, visited and spent three days at Kalavai Orphanage Home. During their stay at the home, they actively involved themselves in cleaning the environment and spreading the message on health and sanitation. Apart from these activities they entertained the inhabitants of the Home in evening times.

As per the instruction received from Programme Officer, NSS, University of Madras, all the NSS Volunteers, Students, Staff Members and NSS Unit Officers, took pledge during the Prayer Hour on 12<sup>th</sup> August 2017.

#### 6. Temple Cleaning

On 14 August 2017, more than 100 volunteers cleaned the temple premises of Sri Irungumatheeswarar Temple, Enathur Village, Kanchipuram and Sri Anandha Padmanabaeswarar, Lingappan Street, Kanchipuram.

#### 7. Students Mass Rally on Clean India

With the permission of Mr. Santhosh Hadimani, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Kanchipuram, Our NSS Team organized a rally on the theme of Clean India. All the Staff Members of our College, NSS Programme Officers, NSS Volunteers, and Students took part in the rally. The rally was flagged off by Dr.V.B. Kumarakrishnan, at 7.30 am in Pookadai Chathiram and the rally reached the college around 8.25 am. The Principal of the Dr.K.R. Venkatesan has announced that our college campus is clean Campus. Swachhta Pakhwara report has been read by Ms. Banupriya, NSS, Programme Officer.
