The Regulations and syllabus for UG & PG Soft Skills, Non-Major, Environmental Studies, Value Education and Internship were discussed in the Board of Studies.

The following changes in B.Sc. Biochemistry Non-Major Elective Syllabus and BA Tamil Non-Major Elective Syllabus were approved by the Board and to take effect from the Academic Year 2017-2018.

1. Department of Biochemistry - Non Major Elective Paper I- Health and Nutrition

Instead of all the vitamins, definition, classification, sources, properties, functions and deficiency symptoms, recommended daily allowances of pantothenic acid, folic acid, biotin, cyanocobalamine, Vitamin D, E and K are included in unit II.

Instead of all the minerals, sources, biological functions, deficiency disorders of trace elements are included in unit IV.

The topics like, role of proteins and carbohydrates in health, functions of protein and carbohydrate and their calorific value, dietary sources and deficiency disorders – Kwashiorkor and Marasmus are removed. Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS), role of International Agencies, Health Based Nutrition Programme are included in unit V.

2. Department of Tamil - Non Major Elective Paper I - Basic Tamil

Names of Tamil Numerics, Relationships, Living places and Things are added in the first semester syllabus of Basic Tamil of the existing syllabus of University of Madras.
