The Board of Studies has discussed the following items

1. Replacement of Business Taxation with Goods and Services Tax (GST):

The Board discussed the relevance of the Business Taxation course prescribed for the BBA Programme in the context of the current business and taxation environment and

noted that, for management students, Goods and Services Tax (GST) is more relevant than traditional taxation, while a basic understanding of taxation principles remains important. The applicability and academic value of introducing GST in place of Business Taxation were examined in view of its widespread implementation across industries and its significance for managerial decision-making. The Board noted the proposal for consideration and resolved to defer the decision, placing the matter for further deliberation and approval in a subsequent meeting.

2. Discussion on the Introduction of Skill Enhancement Courses in collaboration with the Logistics Sector Skill Council

The Board deliberated on strengthening the skill development component of the MBA Programme to better align it with current industry requirements and discussed the proposal to introduce skill enhancement courses offered by the Logistics Sector Skill Council (LSC) in place of the existing courses Spoken and Presentation Skills, Life and Managerial Skills, and Business Etiquette. It was noted that the proposed Courses offered by LSC through online consist of three courses each carrying 2 credits, aimed at enhancing industry exposure, practical skill development, and employability of MBA students. The Board noted the proposal and resolved to defer the decision, placing the matter for further review and approval in a subsequent meeting.

The Board made further discussions on the revision of BBA and MBA syllabus for the academic year 2026-27


