


Our Patrons



Attendance & Jeave of Absence

- 1. The working day is divided into two shifts. Both shift I and shift II will work for 5hours a day in 6 days cycle.
- 2. Attendance will be taken in every hour.
- 3. Students who are not in the class Room when attendance is taken shall be marked absent and shall lose attendance for that session. It shall, however, be open to the lecturer concerned to mark a latecomer present if he is satisfied with the student's explanation.
- 4. A student requiring permission for a period must apply to the lecturer concerned in person before the class begins.
- 5. A fine of Rs.10/- per session and Rs.20/- per day will be levied for absence without leave.
- 6. The list absentees without leave and fine imposed will be pasted every month on the Notice Board. A Student may get his name/number removed from the absentees list on production of an order from the Principal without delay. The Fine shall be paid on or before the working day of the month.
- 7. A student who is continuously absent without leave for six working days or more shall have his name struck off the rolls. They will be eligible for attendance only on readmission.
- 8. Student suffering from sickness for more than 5 consecutive working days shall produce a valid medical certificate.
- 9. Each student is expected to keep a record of attendance.

- 10. Attendance certificates shall be granted only to those students who have attended 75% of the number of working day for each semester provided they have completed the course of instruction to the satisfaction of the authorities and that the progress and conduct have been satisfactory.
- 11. The attendance of each student will be entered in the term certificate register in the course of the first week of the succeeding month after which no alteration can be made.
- 12. Recommendation to the University for exemption in case of shortage of attendance cannot be claimed as a matter of right.
- 13. Application for exemption from the production of attendance certificates (in case of shortage of attendance upto 65%) will not be recommended unless the Principal is satisfied that the shortage is due to causes beyond the student's control.
- 14. Even in such cases the University may require extra work to be put in on other days including holidays to make up for the shortage.
- 15. As per the Rules of University, Student who fails to put in 65% of attendance will not be permitted to write the Examinations and will have to repeat the course in the following year with permission from the University.

Rules Concerning Certificates

- i. Certificates must be applied for in the prescribed form which can be obtained from the office.
- ii. Ordinarily a notice of 48 hours is necessary for the issue of a certificate.
- iii. Degree Certificate or Provisional certificate can be issued only by the University of Madras.
- iv. A Course of study Certificate will be issued, when applied for with a payment of Rs.25/-

University Certificates:

- i. Provisional / Pass Certificate can be obtained from the University for which payment has to be made along with University exam fees.
- ii. Application for migration Certificates should be made to the Registrar, University of Madras through the college.
- iii. A search Fee will be levied for the issue of any certificate if an application is made after three years.

Rules Concerning Juition Fees

The Semester Fees shall be paid in one consolidated amount at the beginning of each Semester. It must be paid on or before the fifth working day of the semester or the date fixed for the payment.

If a student fails to pay his fees on the date fixed for payment, a fine at the rate of Rs.5/- per working day will be levied subject to a maximum of Rs. 20/-. If the fee is not paid before the last working day of the month his name will be struck off from the rolls and he shall not attend classes. He can be readmitted on payment of the fees and fine due together with a readmission fee of Rs.250/-. The rule is applicable to scholarship holders or beneficiaries of any awards also. Non-Payment of fees before the last date we will result in loss of attendance.

Absence from college with or without leave will not be accepted as an excuse for non-payment of fees on the due dates.

General Conduct of students

- 1. Every student should wear a clean and decent formal dress. Wearing T-shirts, Jeans is not permitted.
- 2. Every student shall always wear the identity card.
- 3. No student is expected to leave the class room during a lecture hour without the permission of the lecturer.
- 4. Students shall not make any nosie in moving from class to class.
- 5. No student shall wander around the class room or along the corridors during the class hours.
- 6. No student shall be absent from the college without leave.
- 7. Students are expected to read the notices pasted on the college notice board. Ignorance of any notice thus pasted will not be accepted as an excuse for failing to comply with it.
- 8. Students are forbidden to write or make any marks on the walls or any parts of the college premises or any parts of furniture or throw paper or ink on the floors of the class rooms.
- 9. No notice of any kind shall be circulated among the students or pasted on the notice board without the previous written sanction of the Principal.
- 10. No meeting of any kind shall be held in the college without the prior written permission of the Principal. No money shall be collected by the students from their class mates for any purpose without obtaining prior written permission from the Principal.

- 11. No student shall take part in any agitation directed against the authorities or the Government or engage prominently in any public movement with which it seems undesirable that the students should be associated with.
- 12. Students shall not indulge in any kind of malpractice in examinations. Candidates found guilty shall not be permitted to attend subsequent examinations, and shall be punishable as the Principal decides.
- 13. No student can bring any outsider individually or in groups except on written permission from the Principal and that too only for co-curricular activities.
- 14. Students shall hand over any property found in the premises, which is presumably lost, to the college office with relevant details.
- 15. Students intending to leave the course in the middle will be required to remit the entire fees (3 or 2 Year fees) for the course before taking TC/CC.
- 16. In regard to all matters not specified in the rules, the students shall aim at conducting themselves according to the highest standards of conduct expected of them.
- 17. Cell Phone is Strictly Prohibited in the College. If a Student is found using the cell phone in the class, it will be confiscated and stringent action will be taken.

Note: Under the TN Education Rules the Principal has full power to inflict the following punishment(s)

FINE, LOSS OF ATTENDANCE, LOSS OF TERM CERTIFICATES, SUSPENSION, EXPULSION.

RAGGING

Ragging is a serious offence according to Tamil Nadu Prohibition Act 7 of 1997 an act promulgated to prohibit ragging in Educational Institutions in the State of Tamil Nadu. Criminal Action will be initiated against student(s) found guilty of indulging in ragging inside and outside the College.

Punishments for those found guilty of Ragging in the College:

- Suspension from attending Classes and academic privileges.
- Witholding/widthdrawing Scholarship/Fellowship and other benefits.
- Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
- Witholding Results.
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional/national/or international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.,
- Suspension/Expulsion from hostel.
- Cancellation of Admission.
- Rustication from the Institution.
- Fine Ragging between Rs.25000 and 1 Lakh.
- Collective Punishment: when the persons committing or abetting the crime are not identified, the institution can resort to collective punishment.
- Whosoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or propagates 'within' or without any educational institution shall be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years and shall also be liable to a fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees.

Rules of the Library and Reading Room

- 1. The Library is open to all the members of the College.
- 2. On all the working days the library will be open from 8.30 a.m to 6.00 p.m
- 3. The Library will be closed on Sundays and other College holidays.
- 4. During the vacation the Library will be open only on the days notified.
- 5. Students should show the Identity Card on demand for any transaction in the Library.
- Each student will be issued with two Library cards and one book can be borrowed against each card. One more library card will be issued for reference books.
- 7. Books or periodicals taken through Reference Cards are to be returned on the same day.
- 8. The cards will be given back to the students when the books are returned and fines if any, paid. As long as the cards are in the Library, the students will be held responsible for the books. When a library card is lost the matter should be immediately reported in writing to the Librarian, who will issue a Duplicate card on payment of Rs.50/-, after proper verification. Student of the final year class should return their library cards at the end of the Academic year i.e., on or before 1st April.
- 9. A student is not entitled to keep a book for more than 14 days from the date of issue. Students who fail to return the books on the due date may be allowed a grace period of 5 days at the discretion of the Principal. If any book is overdue beyond 5 working days a fine at the rate of Rs. 2/- per book will be charged on the sixth working day. Thereafter Rs. 1/- per book per day will be levied. The defaulters will not be allowed to use the library till the books are returned and fines paid. Books falling due on a holiday may be returned without fine on the following working day.

- 10. No one is allowed to sub-lend library books taken on loan. No one Should receiver or return the book on behalf of others.
- 11. On receiving the books the students must examine the books then and there and report any damage found to the Librarian before leaving the Library. Otherwise they will be held responsible for any damage that may be detected afterwards.
- In the event of the loss or damage to a book the person responsible shall either
 pay its cost supply the library with a new copy of the book on the due date
 itself.
- 13. Books periodicals etc, must not be underlined, tampered with or defaced in any manner. Book label should not be defaced or torn.
- 14. The Librarian may, for the purpose of cataloguing of for any other purpose, may recall a book at any time even if the normal period of a loan has not expired.
- 15. The Librarian, may form time, reserve books for reference in the Library and the book or the journal taken foe reference in exchange for reference and cards must not be taken out of the Library.
- 16. Reference books may, however, be issued to staff members for class use. They are to be returned to the Library immediately after use.
- 17. Periodicals should be consulted only within the Library. Taking clippings from the journals and attempting other forms of mutilation of library property are strictly forbidden and is liable for penalty when found.
- 18. All payments shall be remitted in Indian Bank the receipt shown to the Librarian.
- 19. Strict silence must be observed in and around the Library and the reading room.
- 20. Suggestions for purchase of library books may be made in writing to the Librarian. Xerox facility is available in the Library.
